

Student Travel Budget

The Department of Public Health Education is committed to supporting its students' professional experiences, such as conferences, workshops, & professional service opportunities. Resources to support these endeavors vary by academic year. As such the following are guidelines for determining the MAXIMUM amount of support a student might expect in a given year. The department will not be able to support ALL students at this level in any given year but will do its best to spread the resources so that as many students as possible can benefit from these experiences.

Support amounts will vary by the academic level of the student as well as by the activity. Other considerations will include the overall cost of the travel relative to the amount requested. As some support comes from travel awards, all students will be asked for information that will help us determine their eligibility.

Academic Level	Type of Travel	Maximum
PhD	Present/Professional Service Conference or Workshop	\$400
PhD	Attend Conference or Workshop	\$300
MPH	Present/Professional Service Conference or Workshop	\$300
MPH	Attend Conference or Workshop	\$250
BS	Present/Professional Service Conference or Workshop	\$250
BS	Attend Conference or Workshop	\$200

All graduate (PhD and MPH) students who are PRESENTING at a conference are also eligible for \$200 from the School of Health and Human Sciences. Students are automatically eligible one time per year.
